The majority of conditions requiring surgical intervention can be diagnosed and treated in primary care – if the practitioner has the skills and confidence to do so. The highly practical course is delivered face-to-face in a small group setting and features surgical sessions on pork parts and simulated models. The course is approved for the Rural Procedural Grant program. Graduates can apply for Accreditation of Prior Certified Learning (APCL) for module 2 of the Postgraduate Diploma in Minor Surgery and then for a Master of Science studied through the Rila Institute of Health Sciences and awarded by the University of Plymouth (UK).
