The HealthCert Doctors for Development Scholarship was established to provide access to quality education in the areas of skin cancer medicine and dermatology for physicians who practice in developing countries and are committed to providing care to their patients despite difficult circumstances. The goal of the scholarship is to enable doctors to achieve better patient outcomes in their home countries by applying and sharing the knowledge they acquired in the online certificate courses delivered by HealthCert Education.

Who can participate?

The HealthCert Doctors for Development Scholarship is available to physicians who volunteer some of their time to care for patients in need. Eligible physicians must permanently reside and practise in a developing country. Non-native English-speaking applicants must have sufficient proficiency in the English language to be able to follow the video lectures and participate in forum discussions. Participants must have basic computer skills and have access to the internet.

One of your referees must be a HealthCert Education employee, alumni, partner, or associate. This referee will know you and HealthCert Education, and they can provide personal encouragement as you study.

Conditions of the scholarship

- If your application is successful, you may select one online course to be completed in one year. Repeat applications in future years are welcome.
- You will continue your volunteer work for the duration of the scholarship.
- Correspondence regarding scholarship decisions will not be entered into by HealthCert Education staff.
- Any photos you send to HealthCert Education (with names changed) may be published on our website under the Doctors for Development Scholarship section.
- Upon completion of the certificate course, participants are kindly asked to submit a short report / testimonial on how they implemented the learning outcomes into their practice and how they benefitted their patients.
